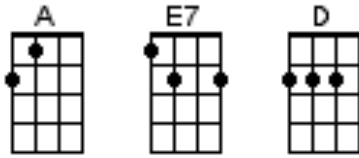


# California Stars words by Woody Guthrie music by Jay Bennett
